From Membership Chair

Please note that Plastics in Buildings and Construction (B&C) Special Interest Group (SIG) is now converted into Plastics in Building and Infrastructure (B&I) division. There are some changes regarding membership we should be aware of as we move from SIG to division. When you renew your membership you can enroll for any number of SIGs for free, however, you can enroll for only two divisions for free. For additional enrollment you need to pay \$10 for each division. If you are a member of Plastics in B&C SIG, you have following options to be a member of Plastics in B & I division,
